

Transportation from and to the airport or train station : \$100 p.p. per trip/Please call to discuss best scheduling times. Pick-up arrangements can be made with the camp directors.

Mini-Excursions: Campers who win weekly room inspection are treated to supper at a local restaurant.

## ARRIVALS

Arrival days are on Sundays between 2:30 and 4:30 P.M. Please do not arrive late as supper is served at 5:00 and is an excellent opportunity for campers to start new friendships. Early arrivals cannot be accommodated.

## FOOD AND PARCELS

A carefully planned, balanced diet will be provided for the camper. We do provide a vegetarian choice at each meal. **Please, do not send food. Sans Souci is not a peanut-free camp.** Campers may receive regular mail. Care packages are allowed. Parcels sent by priority post mail will have to be picked up in the village and so may arrive later than regular mail. For emergency parcels or mail we suggest Purolator or similar delivery.

## VISITING DAY & TELEPHONE

There is no visiting day during a single session. Show day, held on the last day of camp, is considered a visiting day for campers staying longer than one session. Should it be necessary to visit a camper, this can be arranged if the camp is notified prior to the visit. Campers may use the telephone to call a parent for emergencies but both outgoing and incoming calls must be short.

## DEPARTURE DAY

**Two-week session** : Show day is held on Saturday, the last day of a camping session, and commences promptly at 1:00 P.M. This gives parents and friends an excellent opportunity to observe the children on horseback and see how much they have learned from their camping experience. Bring your own lawn chairs to have a comfortable afternoon. We encourage all visitors to stay until the end of the show when certificates are awarded to all campers. Departure is after the horse show between 4 and 5 P.M.

*"Please do not bring any pets on arrival or departure day."*

**One-week session** : For those staying only the first week of a two week session there is no show and departure is on Sunday morning at 11:30 a.m.

## BEFORE YOU SEND YOUR CHILD FOR CAMP

1. Mail the balance of fee by May 1<sup>st</sup> in order to maintain your reservation. We will refund fees in full, minus a \$100 administration fee, if notified by June 1st. Cancellations made after June 1st without a medical certificate, will have 50% of camp fee retained.
2. Check suggested clothing list, make sure you child has sufficient clothing., **clearly marked**.
3. Keep your invoice for a record of the session registered. Please refer to this **invoice number** when contacting us about your child.
4. Do not hesitate to call us if you have any questions or need further help in preparing your child for camp.



### Directions from Mercier Bridge:

Keep Rt. towards 138W. Take 1st exit on Rt. St. Isidore/St. Remi. Turn Lft. on 221S, continue (16km) to Junction 209S(1<sup>st</sup> lights). Turn Rt onto 209S. Continue(10.5km) to Junction with 205. Continue straight on 209S (1.5km) Sans Souci is on your left.

### Directions from the Champlain Bridge:

On bridge take exit 53 for hwy.132W. Continue 15km on hwy 132W to junction 209S( La Belle Province restaurant). Turn Lft. onto 209S to junction 205(26.5km). Continue straight on 209S, Sans Souci is on your left 1.5km after the junction. (450)826-3772.
